

# The Best Roulette Winning Strategies And How You Can Use Them

**Roulette** is one of the most intriguing casino games, as there are thousands of possible betting combinations you can employ. Although it is defined as a game of chance, many professional players and enthusiasts have devoted their lives to researching various winning methods to improve their success.

Nowadays, there are dozens of books, articles, stats, and other useful roulette-related material that can help you enhance your betting technique and get the most out of this casino game. As roulette professionals, we have had an opportunity to read and apply most of these tactics in real life. We have rated all of them and we describe them in this article. Read on!

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## These Are The Best Roulette Strategies

Our team of roulette lovers at Roulette 77 have made a list of the most popular strategies to help people improve their game and have more fun. We have listed them from the most to the least effective and describe how each of them works step-by-step. The list is divided into progressive and non-progressive strategies. Let's take a look!

# Best techniques

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## Progressive Strategies

There are two types of roulette strategy out there: progressive and non-progressive. The only difference between the two is in the way you place bets. The progressive ones suggest that players adjust their bets based on previous results. In other words, they use progressive betting systems in order to help players win.

To explain about these techniques, we need to review some of the most popular strategies. We begin with the Martingale strategy, as the most popular option among players.

### The Martingale Strategy

The Martingale strategy is the most widely used method in casinos worldwide, since many people regard it as the most effective. The approach emerged in 18th-century France, being first applied to simple 'heads-or-tails' games.

Hence, the system is applicable in all types of bets that give you a 50%-50% chance to win. You can apply it to 1-18 or 19-36, red or black, or even or odd.

The idea is to place the minimum bet and keep placing it for as long as you are on a winning streak. As soon as you lose, you need to double the bet size. If you win, you will get your money back plus a minimum on top of that. If you lose – double the bet size once again. The idea is to keep doubling the bet size as long as you lose. Let's see how it works, step-by-step.

Initial bet



loses : double bet



Net profit



1. Find a table that offers a low minimum and high maximum bet.
2. Place the minimum bet (\$1) on red or black and wait for the outcome.
3. If your guess was right, repeat the whole thing.
4. If your guess was wrong, double up (\$2)
5. Keep doubling up as long as you lose, and reset to the minimum whenever you win

#### PROS

- + Guaranteed wins as long as you don't reach the maximum bet
- + Great to recover losses in a short time
- + Great for online casinos

#### CONS

- Tables put limits to maximum bets
- Your bankroll is depleted faster
- Odds go down in long sessions


The Martingale betting system is the safest approach out there, as long as you can find great tables with low minimum and high maximum bets. The entire method relies on maths, as long as you have the budget and don't reach the maximum. However, if you are on a losing streak and guess wrong several times, the element of luck is reintroduced.

## The Reverse Martingale Strategy

The Reverse Martingale method is pretty self-explanatory. The basic difference from the Martingale strategy is that you need to double your bet size every time you win, instead of every time you lose. In other words, if you place \$1 and you win, you should place \$2 in the next round. On the other hand, if you lose, you should keep betting the minimum possible amount.

The Reverse Martingale is based on the fact that all wins and losses come in streaks, and that players should get the most out of the winning streaks. Probability-wise the Reverse Martingale is similar to Martingale – it's all maths, but it takes luck as well.

The system is also considered more aggressive than the regular Martingale, so professionals have come up with milder variants, such as the 3-Step Martingale, where you reset to the minimum bet after three consecutive wins, instead of doubling up for the fourth time.




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## The D'Alembert Strategy

The D'Alembert strategy is named after a legendary roulette player from 18th-century France, called Rond d'Alembert. He came up with a betting system which was based on the Martingale method, adding a couple of tweaks here and there to make it better and more effective. The primary difference from Martingale is that bets are not so aggressive. Instead of doubling up every time players lose, he adopted a much flatter approach where bets increase and decrease gradually.

All you have to do is determine the basic "unit" of betting (\$1 in the action plan below) and add or remove it depending on your score. Let's examine it step-by-step!



1. Find a table that allows low minimum bets and place your initial bet (\$5)
2. If you win, decrease the bet amount by \$1 (\$4)
3. If you lose, increase the bet amount by \$1 (\$6)
4. Repeat!

#### PROS

- + Great for smaller bankrolls
- + Safer than Martingale
- + Really easy to master

#### CONS


- No high gains
- Takes more time than Martingale

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## The Labouchère System

The Labouchère betting method was named after Henry Labouchère, an English politician and avid gambler. The system may seem pretty confusing at first, but once you get into the

swing of things, it's rather interesting. In fact, it's just like playing another game alongside the game of roulette. Let's see how it works in practice.



1. Come up with a sum that you want to win (\$10 for example).
2. Come up with a sequence of numbers that add up to 10 (for example 1-2-1-4-1-1).
3. Place a bet that is the sum of the leftmost and rightmost number in your sequence (\$2 in this case as 1+1=2).
4. If you win, cross those numbers out from your sequence (in this case, your sequence would look like this: 2-1-4-1).
5. If you lose, add the amount you bet to the right end of the sequence (in this case, your sequence would look like this: 1-2-1-4-1-1-2).
6. The goal is to cross out all numbers by always betting the sum of the leftmost and rightmost number.

#### PROS

- + Most of the sessions will be profitable, as this system can return a profit even if you win less than you lose
- + Gives a sense of progress
- + Very interesting to use
- + Doesn't have to be used only on even bets

### CONS

- Stake can be too high if you are on a losing streak

Just like all the systems we covered so far, this is a progressive betting method and relies on placing even bets, but it is also applicable to other roulette bets. However, you should stick to the even ones if you want to get the most out of it.

## The Fibonacci System

The Fibonacci betting method is based on one of the greatest mathematical sequences in the world – the Fibonacci sequence. Popularised by Leonardo Pisano (aka Fibonacci), the sequence of numbers is an endless one where each number is the sum of the previous two in the sequence.

The start of the sequence looks like this: 0, 1, 1, 2, 3, 5, 8, 13, 21, etc. This particular sequence is used as a progressive betting strategy in roulette. Let's explore it!

(0), 1, 1, 2, 3, 5, 8, 13, 21, 34, 55, 89, 144, 233, 377, ...

Each number equals the total sum of the two previous numbers

With a loss, move one step to the right



With a win, move two steps to the left



1. Place an even bet, preferably the minimum possible (\$1 for example).
2. If you lose the bet, place \$1 again (we have to make at least two bets in order to start the sequence).
3. If you lose it again, you need to sum up the previous two bets (both are \$1 in this case) and make a bet that's the sum of the two (\$2).
4. If you lose the bet at the third spin, you need to bet \$3 after that ( $2 + 1 = 3$ ).
5. If you win the bet at the third spin, you need to bet \$1 (which is the previous number in the Fibonacci sequence)

### PROS

- + An interesting system that requires the player to get involved in the game
- + Good for making small profits in short sessions
- + Simple to understand

### CONS

- Stakes get pretty high when on a losing streak
- Not profitable in the long run

The Fibonacci sequence is definitely something that has inspired many scientists and gamblers alike. This strategy is perhaps not as effective as the ones presented previously, but it can be profitable in short sessions.

## Non-Progressive Systems

As previously mentioned, non-progressive betting systems are based on the fact that bets are neither increased nor decreased during your roulette session. In fact, these systems focus on something other than bankroll management.

They aren't as popular as the progressive ones, but are just as entertaining. They don't focus only on even bets, meaning that you can place bets on numbers as well.

### The James Bond Strategy

In one of the James Bond books, the legendary Agent 007 plays roulette, using a system created by his secret agency in order to maximise the winning potential. According to them, this strategy can beat the odds, but it is important to separate fiction from reality.

The Action Plan

1. Place \$14 on the numbers 19-36.
2. Place \$5 on the numbers 13-18.
3. Place \$1 on 0 as an insurance.

This is pretty much all you have to do every time. Let's take a look at the results:

1. You receive \$8 profit if the ball lands on 19-36.
2. You receive \$10 profit if the ball lands on 13-18.
3. You receive \$16 profit if the ball lands on a 0.
4. You lose \$20 if the ball lands on 1-12.

Truth be told, this strategy will definitely NOT give players an edge over casinos, but it can help them have fun and improve their chances of winning. If you are not a fan of progressive betting methods in roulette, this is the next-best thing. It's simple to follow, and there are no complicated calculations in the process.

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## The Biased Wheels Strategy

The biased-wheels strategy is not a betting method. Instead, it focuses on finding roulette wheels that are biased in some way. Many land-based wheels are subject to deterioration over time, resulting in small irregularities. These wheels start favouring some numbers over others, and it is up to players to find such a wheel and make the most of it.

This method is really exciting, as it gives players an opportunity to gain an edge over casinos, if they can just manage to find out the side of the wheel that is favoured. Some gamblers, such as Joseph Jagger and Billy Walters, made a fortune by exploiting biased wheels.

## Other Tips On How To Win At Roulette

Roulette is not always about complex systems, strategies, or finding a loophole. Sometimes, it is enough to follow simple tips and enhance your playing experience. So let's explore some of the most useful pieces of advice and how they could improve your game.



## 1. Focus on a Single-zero Roulette



If you like to play roulette, you probably know that there are a couple of different ones. One of the major points of difference is the zero field – some have one zero and others have two (there are also three-zero roulette games these days). Zeros increase the house edge, so you want to keep it as low as possible, meaning that the **single-zero option** is the best one.

## 2. Don't let emotions take over



Emotions can be tricky, as they may influence our decisions, especially when we play casino games. Roulette is a pretty exciting game, but you need to understand that bets you make out of desperation are not going to help you win the game.

## 3. Explore various betting strategies



We've presented the most popular betting strategies in this article, but it is up to you to find the one that meets your needs. So be sure to explore each of them and see how they work in practice.

## 4. Know when to stop



Every session lasts as long as you choose, or when you run out of money. If you are not doing well, you should stop, walk away and come back another day. In roulette, just like in life, there are good and bad days, and you want to profit from the good ones.
